Rules & Regulations

Use of Veterans' Memorial Plots. Certain sections of the cemetery have been set aside to honor those veterans who have honorably served in the military or naval forces of the United States, to include the Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, Coast Guard and WWII Merchant Marine. Burial spaces in these sections are furnished without charge to eligible veterans. Internment and headstone placement fees are the responsibility of the veteran's estate. Flat bronze or granite headstones are required; ledger and marble headstones are not allowed.

Section I – Eligibility Requirements

- A. For interment at BCEVC, the veterans character of discharge or separation from active military, naval, air or coast guard service must be honorable or under honorable conditions. As a general rule, an honorably discharged veteran must have active duty other than “active duty for training”.
- B. It shall be the responsibility of the veteran, the veteran's next-of-kin, or designated agent to furnish documentary evidence necessary to establish the eligibility of the veteran before the interment can be made of the deceased veteran.
- C. The Cemetery Board Chairman, Sexton, or their designee, shall be ultimately responsible for eligibility determinations.

Decoration of Graves in Veterans' Memorial Plots. Decoration of these graves may be provided through the Veterans Organizations, relatives or friends, and shall be in accordance with current Evergreen Cemetery Rules and Regulations.
