## APPENDIX 2 – CITY UTILITY RATE TABLE – METERED CUSTOMERS.

**Water rates.** Customers who have functional and accessible water meters installed on the premises shall be billed at the following rate:

\$7.20	Per 1,000 gallons between 0001 and 5,000 metered gallons or less, plus
.70	Per 1,000 gallons between 5,001 and 15,000 metered gallons, plus
.60	Per 1,000 gallons between 15,001 and 55,000 metered gallons, plus
.50	Per subsequent 1,000 metered gallons

Plus:

\$ 5.00	Arsenic Abatement Rate for households in trailer park
\$ 5.00	Arsenic Abatement Rate if less than 25 employees
\$10.00	Arsenic Abatement Fee if 25 or more employees

\$1.33	Water Tower Maintenance Fee

EXAMPLE A: 203,600 metered gallons of water

$$203,600 - 5,000 - 10,000 - 40,000 = 148,600$$

$$(7.20 \times 5) + (.70 \times 10) + (.60 \times 40) + (.50 \times 148.6) = 141.30 + (10.00 + 1.33) = \$152.63$$

$$\$36.00 + 7.00 + 24.00 + 74.30 = 141.30 + 11.33 = \$152.63$$

EXAMPLE B: 6,825 metered gallons of water

$$6,825 - 5,000 = 1,825$$

$$(7.20 \times 5) + (.70 \times 1,825) = 37.27 + (5.00 + 1.33) = \$43.60$$

$$\$36.00 + 1.27 = \$37.27 + (5.00 + 1.33) = \$43.60$$

**Sewer rates.** Customers who have functional and accessible water meters installed on the premises and are connected to the City sewer system shall be billed at the following rate:

\$5.76	Per 1,000 gallons between 0001 and 5,000 metered gallons or less, plus
.56	Per 1,000 gallons between 5,001 and 15,000 metered gallons, plus
.48	Per 1,000 gallons between 15,001 and 55,000 metered gallons, plus
.40	Per subsequent 1,000 metered gallons

Plus:

\$3.67	Storm Sewer and Maintenance Fee
--------	---------------------------------

EXAMPLE A: 203,600 metered gallons of water

$$203,600 - 5,000 - 10,000 - 40,000 = 148,600$$

$$(5.76 \times 5) + (.56 \times 10) + (.48 \times 40) + (.40 \times 148.6) = 113.04 + 3.67 = \$116.71$$

$$\$28.80 + 5.60 + 19.20 + 59.44 = 113.04 + 3.67 = \$116.71$$

EXAMPLE B: 6,825 metered gallons of water

$$(5.76 \times 5) + (.56 \times 1,825) = 29.82 + 3.67 = \$33.49$$

$$\$28.80 + 1.02 = 29.82 + 3.67 = \$33.49$$

### Effective Date Of Ordinance

This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after adoption – August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

INTRODUCTION:

This Ordinance was introduced by Councilmember William Walters on June 28, 2010, during a Regular Meeting of the Brown City Council. The Public Hearing thereon was held on July 12, 2010.

MOTION AND VOTE:

Moved by Councilmember William Walters seconded by Councilmember Dan Loutzenhiser, to amend Appendix 1 and Appendix 2 of Chapter 52 of the Brown City Code to reflect a necessary increase in the Storm Sewer Fee and adjust metered rates from quarterly to monthly.
